ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING. An encouraging ‘signed in’ attendance of 34 members (22 Committee, and 12 individuals, representing some 10 clubs), no doubt mainly due controversial items on the agenda, were welcomed by the Chairman, however this total may have been increased if there had been sufficient publicity in the local “Press”. Results of the Notices of Motion are shown below:-

1. Rule 22. The annual subscription shall be decided at any A. G. M.

Amend to read : “The annual subscription shall be decided by the General Purposes Committee without the necessity for ratification at the Annual General Meeting.”.

Withdrawn by the GPC, after a very convincing point of view from the floor,

2. Increase the cost of the Year Book by £3.00 to	£36.00, pro rata as below.	**

3. Introduce a separate permit for the Laybourne Lakes complex (essentially to provide sufficient funding, mainly for the maintenance of the approach road) at a price of £4.00, this to be paid additionally to the cost of the main book in all categories. ‘Ring-fenced’ for Laybourne.

Carried, after a lengthy discussion, the voting being 19 for the motion with 9 against. (2/3 rd’s majority).

** This means that any angler wishing to fish the Laybourne Lakes complex will have to add £4.00 to the category of book price that they wish to buy Those anglers who do not fish the Laybourne complex will only be required to pay the above standard fee. Any of these anglers wishing to change their mind and fish Laybourne at a later date will be required to pay the additional levy at that time. ** A method of distinguishing the Laybourne portion of the year book is currently under consideration with the printer.
